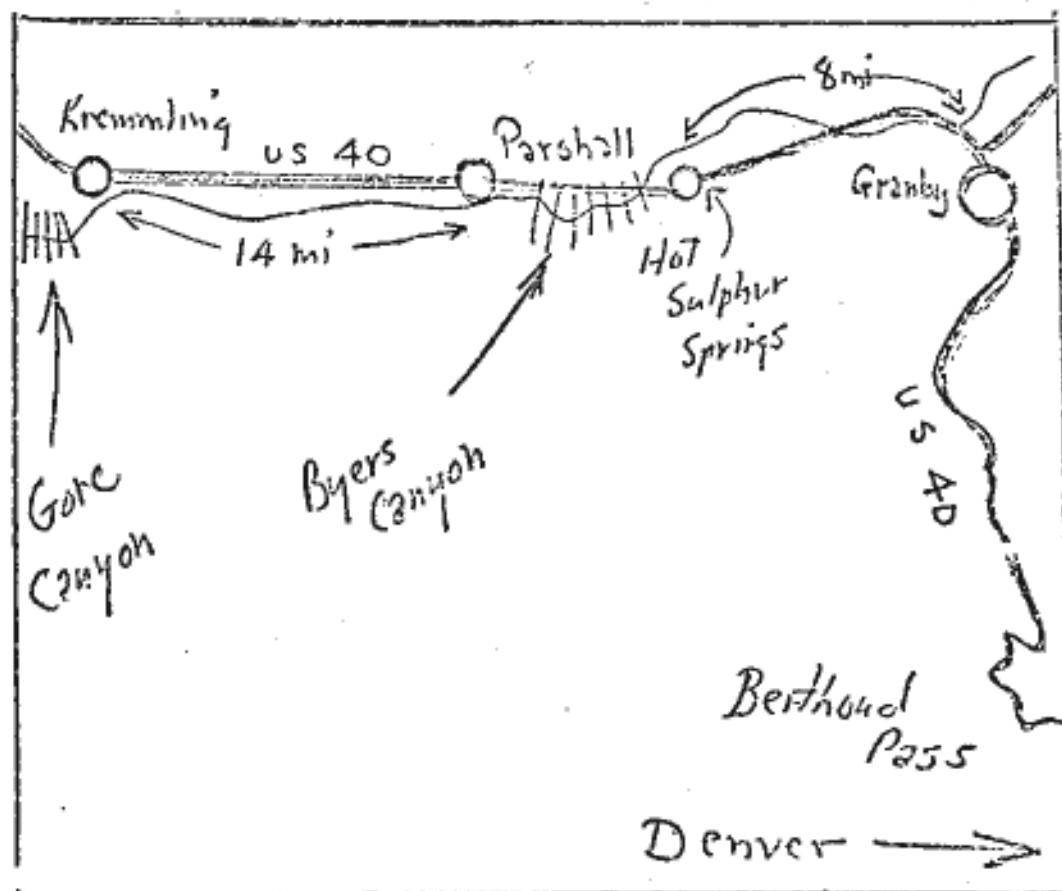
Weather and water conditions permitting, we will run the Upper Colorado in two sections: Granby to Hot Sulphur Springs on Saturday afternoon, and from Parshall to Kremmling on Sunday.

The former trip is an easy 8 mi. float, and according to H. Bauer (Grayling Canoe Co. publication) it "...may easily be floated with some minor rapids down to Hot Sulphur Springs..."

From Parshall (below Byers Canyon) it is reported to be a "pleasant run" by Folbot publication, to Kremmling.

We have substituted this section for the State Bridge-Burns part since it is closer to home - an easy 90 mile drive from Denver to Granby, and also since it may be easier for the intermediate canoeist.

If water conditions are unfavorable, we have the alternative of camping and canoeing on Granby Lake (Southeast corner is particularly scenic).
